

District-Wide Remote Learning Model

In anticipation of possible closure of the district/building based on rising COVID cases and staff shortages, the district has created a District -Wide Full Remote Learning Model.

Once a move to a remote learning model is announced, the district will implement the plan and students and families in the affected building(s) will receive specific information from their building principal.

A District -Wide Full Remote Learning Model will go into effect at the time of, and remain in place during, the duration of the building closure. The information below is an outline of that plan.

STUDENT SCHEDULE: K-12

1. The Blue and Gold student cohorts will be blended into one group / class / section per day. All students – regardless of their Blue / Gold designation – shall attend daily.
2. **Students are required to be in attendance every day, Monday-Friday.** Friday will continue under the current format, subject to change if school closures remain in effect beyond two weeks.
3. Students will follow their daily schedules and attend each Zoom meeting.
4. School hours shall remain the same Monday – Friday.

INSTRUCTION, ATTENDANCE, GRADING:

1. All current methods, protocols, and policies shall remain in effect.

SPECIAL EDUCATION & RELATED SERVICES:

1. All Special Education programs, classes, and services will revert to a virtual / remote format and follow a student's schedule.
2. Speech, Occupational and Physical Therapy will be provided virtually where possible. Alternative plans will be provided to families directly based on consultation with the Director of Special Education.

FOOD SERVICE:

1. Food service will continue with meals being available for families as needed. Specific times and locations will be shared with families when / if the change to a full remote occurs.

BOCES Programs:

1. All BOCES programs will remain as currently scheduled.
